PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING Because of You...

2015 is a banner year for acquiring and developing innovative permanent supportive housing communities!



Slated to open in the Spring of 2015, the Kaufmann Apartments at Step Up on Colorado is a \$14M capital project with 34 units of permanent supportive housing in Santa Monica. Also in 2105, Step Up will direct its expertise and highly successful track record to create a privatized model of long term, integrated housing and supportive services to address the needs of families with adult children experiencing mental health issues: Family-Centered Housing.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING & PLACEMENT Because of You...

Twenty Vocational participants were placed in unsubsidized employment, and sixty eight members participated in supportive employment in 2014! Step Up is launching a Hollywood vocational enterprise, The Vine Street Café at Step Up on Vine in 2015, thanks to a \$420K award through Councilman Mitch O'Farrell's office.



The Vine Street Café will be a for-profit enterprise, with paid on-the-job work training and real-world experience for participants. The funding is specifically to create 12 full-time positions for low-income individuals who are a part of Step Up's Work Force Development Program.

2015 brings an increased focus on Transitional Aged Youth experiencing homelessness and mental health issues with outreach, engagement, supportive housing & services through the programs of Daniel's PLACES! Also, in a new partnership with the Anti-Recidivism Coalition, Daniel's Places provides housing & support services in Sylmar for twenty-four young adults at risk of incarceration.
