PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

The #1 requested supportive service...

In 2017 Step Up ended homelessness for 216 individuals through permanent supportive housing, including 54 Veterans who moved into Building 209, Step Up's latest housing community on the West LA VA Campus. Step Up Inland Empire's outreach and engagement team, working together for less than a year, ended homelessness for 143 individuals in an area stretching from Ontario to Indio. The team also engaged over 500 individuals experiencing homelessness and complex needs, linking many to critically needed resources. Daniel's Places, Step Up's Transitional Age Youth (TAY) program, connected 21 youth to stable housing and supportive services tailored to their needs.

2017 Milestones

- Over 200 members participated in supported employment training and placement programs.
- 49 individuals moved into unsubsidized employment, including 24 TAY.
- 49 individuals enrolled in educational programs, including 14 designed for TAY.
- Over 45,000 plus meals were prepared by Vocational participants.

Step Up's Vocational Job Coaching and training tracks for self-sustaining member work include:

- Janitorial training & proper safety training.
- Administrative work & front desk reception.
- Back kitchen operations including food prep, preparing meals, food safety training, grilling, and dishwashing.
- Retail sales including stocking, ordering, sales transactions, and customer service.
